COVERED AT THE AUGUST, 2017 BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

The 2017 SMSC All Members annual meeting will be upon us shortly (in mid-November). In preparation for that, your board approved the nomination process used last year for the next, and all future elections of board members. Here is that process:

RULES FOR NOMINATIONS:

- 1. No nominations will be accepted during the all member meeting, in November.
- All nominations must be received by the board before the end of the November board meeting. (Nominations will be accepted during the September and November board meetings. Both of these board meetings will be held at the SMSC Clubhouse, at 7:30PM.)

RULES FOR NOMINEES:

- 1. The nominee must agree to run for the board BEFORE being nominated. Nominees not present, when the nomination is made, should expect to be contacted by a member of the board to confirm their agreement to run for the board.
- 2. Nominees should be prepared to speak, for 2 minutes or less, regarding their qualifications, interests, area of service, and expected contribution to the leadership of the club, at the November all member meeting. If prior commitments preclude the nominee's participation at this meeting, the nominee should designate a representative to read their written statement.

EXPECTATIONS FOR THOSE ELECTED:

- 1. Participate in all SMSC board meetings and activities.
- 2. Contribute to the SMSC in a positive way.
- 3. Invest time and labor in supporting SMSC and its members.
- 4. Assume a position of responsibility and service on the SMSC board.
- 5. Have a desire to serve and to improve SMSC.

We are looking for a club treasurer to start in 2018. If you have an accounting background or have served as a treasurer for another group, please consider running for this position. Note that SMSC employs a bookkeeper to maintain our books so that would not be part of the duties. The treasurer does not need to be a member of the board of directors so it isn't a requirement that you be on the board. The treasurer position is elected by the board of directors. Every member is responsible to know, follow, and enforce firearms safety and all posted rules at all times.

If you bring a guest, you are responsible for them and their actions while on the range. They must also provide us with a signed and dated waiver form. You may download and print the waiver form ahead of your trip to the range:

<u>http://www.smsclub.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/01/waiver.pdf</u> or you may get a copy of the waiver from the Range Manager. Please provide the Range Manager with the waiver before entering the range.

To keep everyone safe, members who violate any posted range rule will receive a warning on their first offense. The second offense will result in range access suspension until review with Board for the purpose of reaching a decision regarding when to allow access again.

Do not let anyone through the gate with you, either coming in or going out, other than your immediate family or your ONE personal guest. <u>Every member must badge in and out.</u> Your SMSC ID badge should be visibly displayed at all times inside the fenced-in (range) areas.

Eye and ear protection is required at all times for everyone inside the fenced-in area.

You must also badge out of the range! This is to help ensure we know who is using the range. Be sure that you do not allow anyone to "tailgate" when entering OR LEAVING the range. Everyone should badge in <u>and</u> out. Do this for your own protection.

Security cameras have been installed, and are fully operational. These have already helped to make the range safer and have greatly reduced the amount of damage done to the range. Be sure you read the posted rules and follow them!

Before driving out to the range, be sure it is open by checking out the online calendar at <u>http://www.smsclub.org/calendar</u> to ensure that no special event is scheduled.

Change in membership details: *Membership is for the member ONLY. The member's spouse* or partner, sharing the same address, per information on their driver's licenses, and their children or grandchildren under age 18, living at the same address, are allowed on the range with the member for no additional charge. Spouses or partners, with the same address, may have their own badge for range access if they pay the badge fee (\$10), complete the Safety Orientation, and provide a completed Waiver.

Club WiFi guest password is "clubhouse" (without quotation marks).

You are responsible to keep the club notified of your current email address. The club uses email and the web site (<u>www.smsclub.org</u>) <u>EXCLUSIVELY</u> to communicate with members. If your email address changes, please notify us via email at <u>clubmail@smsclub.org</u>. We use email to notify members of their renewal date. If you do not have a valid email address on file, you will NOT be notified. This newsletter is also emailed, and it is published on the web site. It contains information you need to know. Without email, you must go to the club's web site to stay current on important club business, rules, etc.

Safety orientation class/badge replacment dates and times are on the calendar at <u>www.smsclub.org</u>. Classes are not necessarily always on the same day each month, nor will classes always be held at the same time. Our next class is Thursday, September 7, 2017.

You may purchase a lifetime membership. The current price is \$1500. The fee was raised in February of 2015, and announced at that time.
