## **COVERED AT THIS MONTH'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

#### January Board of Directors meeting will be:

- 7 PM, Thursday, January 9, at SMSC Clubhouse
- Members always welcome.
- Non-members wishing to address the board are welcome through the Non-Member Business portion of the meeting.

#### Financial information was posted in the clubhouse:

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- Financials are relatively flat 2018-to-2019.
- Effective January 01, 2020, a **membership price increase** to \$100 will take effect. The purchase price for a lifetime membership remains at 20 times the annual membership fee, so this will be \$2,000, effective January 01, 2020.
- November income was up, likely to be down this month. We should break even this year.
- Property taxes on SMSC land total \$1087, down \$45 from last year.
- People's co-op has a new rating system for electricity pricing. We are on their lowest, least expensive tier.

#### General Operations Information:

- **Caretaker housing:** The trailer is failing and needs to be replaced. Windows are rotting out of the walls. There is a hole in the floor.
  - Modular home requires a basement, which would require re-doing all of the septic and water.
  - Removing old trailer: apprx. \$4500
  - New double-wide: apprx. \$120,000
  - New single-wide: apprx. \$85,000
  - Most used trailers are already set up on a location. Moving them is very expensive.
  - Homes of Harmony helps with permitting and setup (skirting, septic and water hook up).
  - Gas and electric hook-up are SMSC's responsibility.
  - We will get 3 bids before making a decision.
  - Mark will assist in selecting the unit to be purchased.

- Calendar requests:

- Indoor range air quality: Steve Green Heating & A/C Inc. to provide estimate. E Wellhave sized the equipment we would need (3000 CFM make-up air unit, 3500 CFM exhaust unit, each has 2 HP 220VAC motor. Total cost of these, without shipping: \$12,000).
- **SMTC asked to form into a single club** with SMSC and SMTC merged. B Rognholt, H Melville, D Black, R Carlson, T Gerber, D Morris will meet and discuss.

You are responsible to keep your email address current. The club uses email and the club website (www.smsclub.org) EXCLUSIVELY to communicate with members. Please add this address to your list of approved email addresses. You must have a valid email address on file to be notified of your renewal date. This newsletter is emailed and published on the club's web site. It contains information you need to know. #### Change in membership/guest details:

**Membership** is for the member ONLY. The member's spouse or partner, who shares the same address per information on their driver's licenses, may have their own badge for range access if they pay the badge fee (\$10), complete the Safety Orientation, and provide a completed Waiver.

**If you bring a guest/guests, you are responsible for them** and their actions while on the range. Badge holders must supervise and take responsibility for their guests at all times. They are legally responsible for any damage caused by themselves or their guests, including the consequences of any bullet fired.

Each guest (including children) must provide SMSC with a signed and dated waiver form before using the range. Parents must sign the waiver for each child. You may download and print the waiver form before coming to the range at:

<u>https://www.smsclub.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/01/waiver.pdf</u>, or get a copy of the waiver from the box at the gate, and complete it before entering the fenced area of the range.

Provide the Range Manager with the waiver before entering the range, or deposit it in the box at the Range Manager's home.

**Guests:** Badge holders may bring family members as guests to the range. Up to three non-family guests are also permitted. All guests must be known to the badge holder.

The badge holder and guests must limit their range use to a maximum of three firing points (lanes), which must be adjacent. The badge holder and guests must stay together at all times.

Every person in the group must have turned in a signed waiver, as described above. Minors must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

Club WiFi guest password is "clubhouse" (without quotation marks).

### ADDITIONAL RANGE INFORMATION

#### Range Hours:

**Every member is responsible** to know, follow, and enforce firearms safety and all posted rules at all times. We suggest you regularly review our Standard Operating Procedures (S.O.P.). You can download SOPs <u>here</u>.

**To keep everyone safe,** members who violate any posted range rule will receive a warning on their first offense. The second offense will result in range access suspension until review with the Board of Directors for the purpose of reaching a decision regarding when to allow access again.

**Do not allow anyone to tailgate (i.e., come through the gate with you),** either entering or leaving the range, other than your own family and your personal guests. <u>Every</u> <u>member must badge in and out.</u> Your SMSC ID badge should be visibly displayed at all times inside the fenced-in (range) areas. **You must also badge out of the range!** This is to help ensure we know who is using the range. Do this for your own protection.

Eye and ear protection is required at all times for everyone inside the fenced-in area.

**Before driving to the range,** we recommend you check the on-line calendar at <u>https://www.smsclub.org/calendar</u> to ensure the range is open and that no special event is scheduled for the time you plan to come and shoot.

**If you require handicapped access to the range, contact our range manager.** The range is now locked, and is normally accessible only through the badge-reader-controlled gate just east of the clubhouse. You can check out a key for the west-side gate should you require it.
