Video System

Several years ago, our range added a closed circuit video surveillance system with these goals in mind:

- Improving our internal security (see who is on the range, did they all badge in, etc.)
- Limit the club's liability by being able to show that the club's ranges were or were not in use at a particular time and be able to see what activities were happening at any given time.
- And frankly to reduce the amount of horseplay and rules violations that were occurring at the time.

The system has worked well but it is time for a serious upgrade to improve our range safety, security and reduce our potential liability.

Here's the ask: we have a lot of dedicated people on our board of directors but none of us has much, if any, experience in sizing, selecting and installing a modern video system. If you have any of those skill and
